POLICY TRANSPORTATION - WALKERS & RIDERS

CODE EEAA

The M.S.A.D. #46 Board of Directors, in compliance with State law dealing with pupil transportation, will provide transportation for all students living beyond reasonable distances from their schools as the Board has determined. This distance is defined as ½ mile for rural students and 1½ miles for in-town students.

Rural students are those living more than 1½ miles from the Dexter Primary School and the Dexter Middle School. Rural students, Grade 5 through Grade 12, are expected to walk up to ½ mile to a designated bus stop as determined by the Transportation Director and Superintendent of Schools.

In-town Dexter students from Grades K-4 are expected to walk to designated bus stops as determined by the Transportation Director and the Superintendent. In-town Dexter students from Grades 5-12 are expected to walk up to 1½ miles to Dexter Schools.

Students will ride only the designated bus unless a note from school personnel and/or approval from the Transportation Director is obtained by the driver.

The Transportation Director and the Superintendent are responsible for establishing limits, determine unsafe or inaccessible conditions and making necessary changes or exceptions. Appeals may be made to the Board of Directors.

Current administrative rules, regulations and mileage limits are attached.
